Together they form a thick, dense turf with a massive root system. This is the ideal combination of grass seed varieties for a beautiful, durable and healthy Colorado lawn.*

*On new turf areas, the addition of organic material (3 cu yards per 1,000 sq ft) and tilling to a depth of 6" will greatly enhance the ability of the turf to develop a thick root system, which will save water and reduce the incidence of weeds.*

*\*When overseeding, cover seed with ¼ inch of organic material.*

*\* Pro-Rich Turf Food can be used at time of planting at ½ normal application rates.*

*Seed must be covered lightly and kept consistently moist until germination occurs. Seed will begin to germinate within 7-10 days when planted in spring, summer or early fall. After germination, gradually increase watering duration and decrease frequency to encourage development of a thick, deep root system.*

*Avoid use of herbicides for at least 6 weeks after germination.*
